

HOUSE HUNTING FENG SHUI CHECKLIST

OUTSIDE THE HOME

- ☐ The home feels supported and comfortably held within its surroundings (through trees, neighboring structures, landscaping, hillside, etc.)
- ☐ The house sits at or above street level
- ☐ The surrounding environment feels calm and welcoming
- ☐ The path to the front door is easy and inviting
- ☐ The home is free from major power poles, harsh structures, or heavy visual pressure nearby
- ☐ The house feels emotionally pleasant upon arrival

ENTRY & FLOW

- ☐ There is space for energy to gather at the entrance (Ming Tang)
- ☐ The home feels open rather than cramped or chaotic
- ☐ Staircase placement feels balanced and not aligned with the front door
- ☐ The layout feels coherent and easy to move through

BEDROOMS & REST

- ☐ There is room for the bed to be in the commanding position
- ☐ The bed is not directly aligned with any doorway
- ☐ There is no bathroom directly behind the headboard
- ☐ The bedroom feels calm, protected, and restorative
- ☐ The bedroom is located in a quieter area of the home

LIGHT & DAILY LIFE

- ☐ Main living spaces receive sunlight and feel alive and energized
- ☐ Bedrooms feel quieter and more restful and are located at the back of the house
- ☐ The stove is placed in a supported position rather than in the middle of an island
- ☐ Doors and windows open and close smoothly and securely

HIDDEN STRESSORS

- ☐ The home is free from mold or water damage
- ☐ The garage and parked cars are not directed toward the main living areas
- ☐ The home is free from major power poles, harsh structures, or heavy visual pressure nearby
- ☐ The house feels emotionally light rather than heavy or stagnant
- ☐ The home has not been sitting vacant for an unusually long time
- ☐ My body feels relaxed, open, and comfortable in the space
